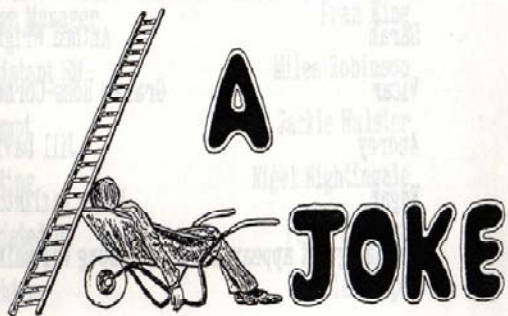


BEYOND
